### **Mechanism of Action:**

- Amoxycillin interferes with bacterial cell wall synthesis by binding to penicillin-binding proteins, leading to cell lysis and death.
- **Potassium Clavulanate** binds irreversibly to beta-lactamase enzymes produced by resistant bacteria, protecting Amoxycillin from enzymatic degradation and extending its antibacterial spectrum.
