Mechanism of Action:

Diclofenac Diethylamine inhibits the enzyme cyclooxygenase (COX-1 and COX-2), reducing the synthesis of prostaglandins, which are responsible for inflammation and pain. It acts locally to reduce swelling and discomfort.

- **Linseed Oil** is rich in omega-3 fatty acids and exhibits anti-inflammatory properties. It also improves the percutaneous absorption of diclofenac, enhancing its efficacy.
- **Methyl Salicylate** acts as a **counterirritant**, stimulating sensory receptors and creating a sensation that distracts from deeper musculoskeletal pain.
- Menthol stimulates cold receptors in the skin, providing a cooling sensation followed by increased local blood flow, which assists in pain relief and muscle relaxation.

Contraindications:

- 1. Known hypersensitivity to Diclofenac, Salicylates, Menthol, or any excipient.
- 2. Open wounds, eczema, or skin infections at the site of application.
- 3. Patients with known aspirin or NSAID-induced asthma or allergic reactions.
- 4. Use in pregnant women during the third trimester is not recommended.
- 5. Not to be used on mucosal surfaces or in the eyes.
