Mechanism of Action:

 Paracetamol acts centrally by inhibiting the enzyme cyclooxygenase (COX), particularly COX-2, thereby reducing the production of prostaglandins involved in fever and pain.

- Phenylephrine HCl is a selective alpha-1 adrenergic receptor agonist that causes vasoconstriction of nasal blood vessels, leading to decreased nasal swelling and congestion.
- **Chlorpheniramine Maleate** is a first-generation antihistamine that blocks H1 receptors, preventing the effects of histamine, which causes symptoms like sneezing, itching, and watery eyes.
- This combination provides **multi-symptom relief** targeting the key aspects of cold and flu symptoms in children.

Contraindications:

- 1. Hypersensitivity to any of the ingredients.
- 2. Severe hepatic or renal impairment.
- 3. Children with uncontrolled hypertension or heart problems (due to phenylephrine).
- 4. Glaucoma or urinary retention (due to antihistamine).
- 5. Use of monoamine oxidase inhibitors (MAOIs) within the last 14 days.

Side Effects:

- 1. Drowsiness or sedation (due to chlorpheniramine)
- 2. Nausea, vomiting, or mild stomach upset
