#### **Mechanism of Action:**

- Rabeprazole is a substituted benzimidazole that suppresses gastric acid secretion by specifically inhibiting the H+/K+ ATPase enzyme system (the proton pump) at the secretory surface of the gastric parietal cell.
- This inhibition blocks the final step of acid production, regardless of the stimulus (acetylcholine, histamine, or gastrin), resulting in significant reduction of both basal and stimulated gastric acid secretion.
- Its action is prolonged due to covalent binding, and it does not affect gastric motility.

#### **Contraindications:**

- Hypersensitivity to Rabeprazole, substituted benzimidazoles, or any excipients
- Caution in severe hepatic impairment

- Not recommended for pediatric use without supervision
- Avoid in patients with suspected gastrointestinal malignancy without evaluation

### **Side Effects:**

- 1. Headache, nausea, dizziness
- 2. Diarrhea or constipation
- 3. Injection site irritation or phlebitis
- 4. Rare: Hypomagnesemia, elevated liver enzymes, rash
- 5. Long-term use may be associated with gastric polyps, vitamin B12 deficiency roducts From Re
